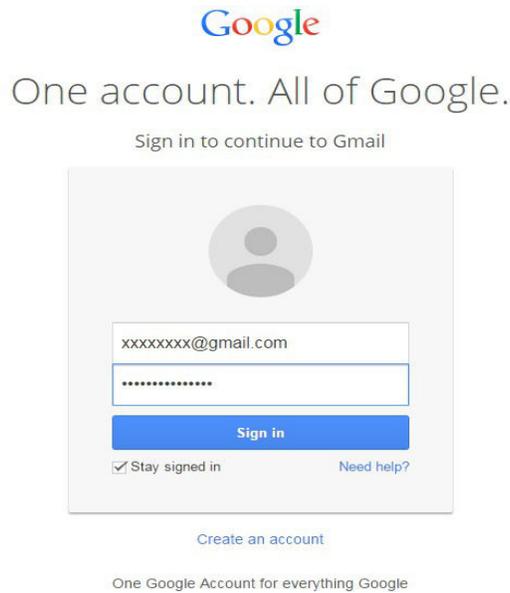

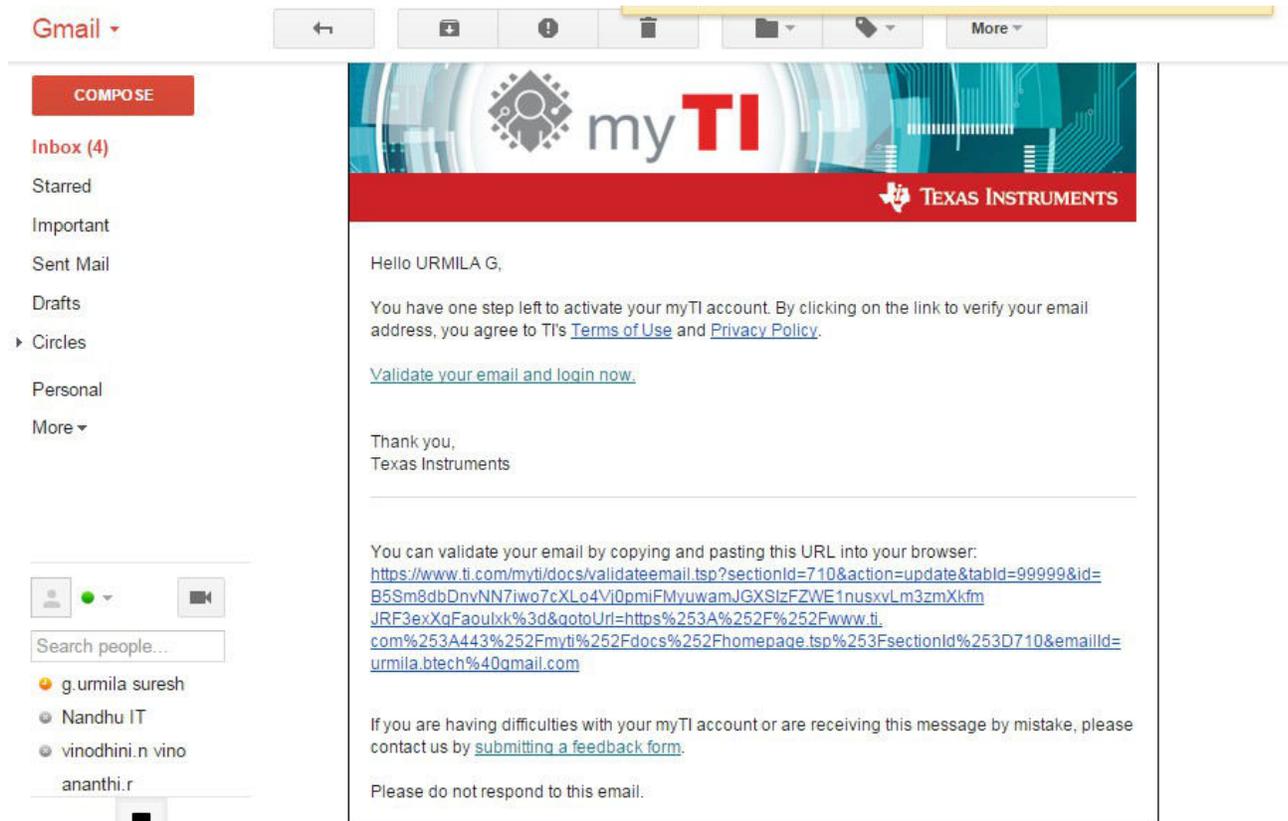

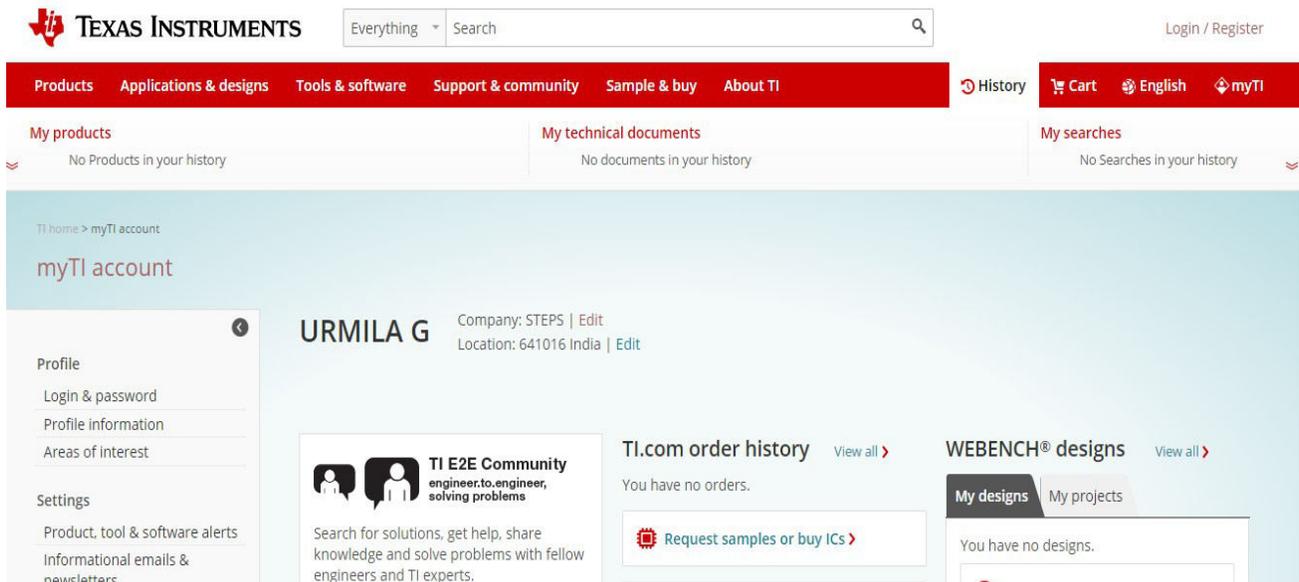
STEP 4 : Go to the **E-mail** which you have created with TI
